Born August 31, 1971, Christopher "Chris" Tucker is an American actor and comedian. He is best known for playing the role of Detective James Carter in the *Rush Hour* film series. Tucker became a frequent stand up performer on Def Comedy Jam in the 1990s. He came to prominence in 1995 film *Friday* alongside Ice Cube, and then appeared in Luc Besson's *The Fifth Element* before beginning work on the highly commercially successful *Rush Hour* films. In 2006 he negotiated an unprecedented \$25 million salary to appear in *Rush Hour 3*, which at the time made him the highest paid actor in Hollywood. Tucker is also a humanitarian and spends much of his spare time traveling and working with his foundation. His latest film, the critically acclaimed *Silver Lining Playbook* with Robert DeNiro and Bradley Cooper, is receiving Oscar® attention.
