Hailing from Possum Kingdom, S.C., the Rinehart brothers, Bear and Bo join bass player Seth Bolt in a determined effort to create a statement-making album recorded at their Plantation Studios in Charleston, S.C. In the end, the band surfaced with a timeless album rooted in classic American rock and roll. On *The Reckoning*, songs delve into broken dreams, statement pieces and taking chances. *The New York Times* hails NEEDTOBREATHE as a "gifted band" making Southern rock that "is beginning to reach for the far seats of the arena."
