

CHRIS ROCK: TOTAL BLACKOUT TOUR 2017

Mobile phones will not be allowed at this event

(this restriction also includes smart watches, cameras and all other recording and mobile devices)

Per the request of the Chris Rock tour, this is a strict NO MOBILE PHONES ALLOWED event. **Seven things you need to know before entry:**

1. **Please leave your phones in your car or at home.** Anyone who brings a phone will be required to place it in a locked pouch provided by the tour.
2. Everyone is subject to inspection before entry, including the use of metal detectors.
3. Entry lines will be lengthy, please plan to arrive at DPAC one-hour prior to show time to ensure you do not miss the start of the show.
4. **Anyone found with a phone inside the venue will be immediately ejected without refund.**
5. Due to this policy, mobile tickets will be disabled for this event.
6. For guests with mobile tickets on their phones, you can log into your Ticketmaster account beginning 72 hours before the scheduled performance time and print a PDF of your tickets.
7. This PDF ticket will enable you entry to the event so that you can leave your phone in your car.

We strongly recommend you do not bring your phone, but if you do, here is what you can expect:

- Chris Rock's Total Blackout Tour has partnered with Yondr, a new technology company that helps create phone-free events for comedy and concert tours. Anyone using a mobile phone in the seating area will be immediately escorted out of the venue without refund.
- Upon arrival, **all phones(or other mobile devices including smart watches)** will be secured in locked Yondr pouches that will remain locked until the end of the show.
- Guests maintain possession of their phones or other mobile devices throughout the night, and if needed, may access their phones at designated Yondr unlocking stations in the lobby. To avoid waiting in lines before or after the event to obtain and return Yondr pouches, **please leave your phone in your car or at home.**
