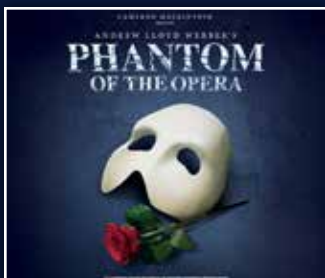

Payment Plans

Seats for most shows can be reserved with a 10% non-refundable deposit due at time of booking to lock in your seats with final payments due six weeks before the show opens at DPAC. Please note for some multi-week blockbuster shows, final payments are due eight weeks prior to the show.

The show was conceived and is directed by Cirque du Soleil Senior Artistic Director James Hadley, a 25-year veteran of circus productions and live theater.

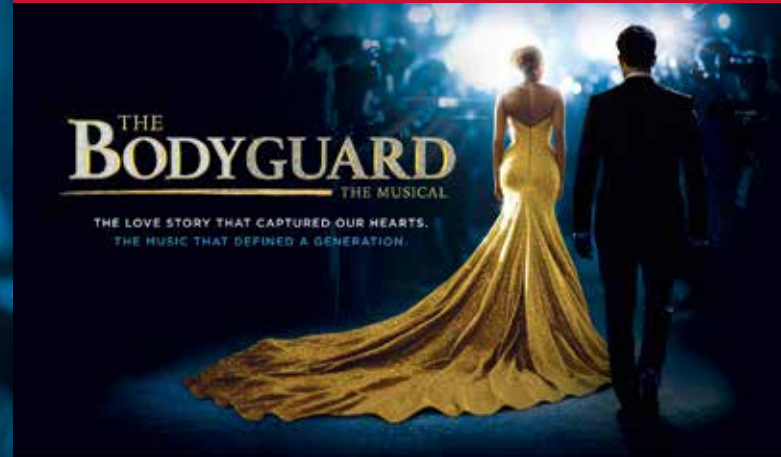

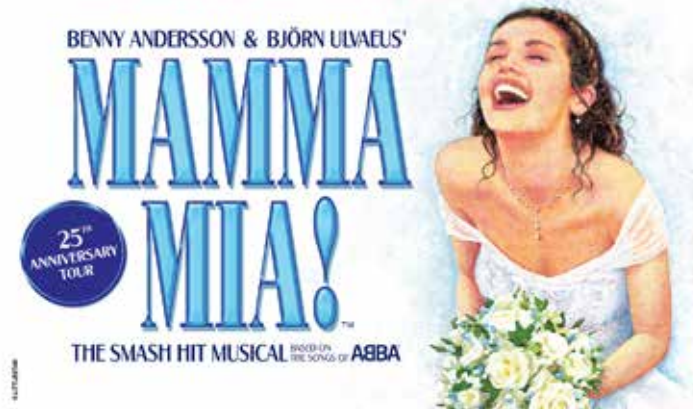

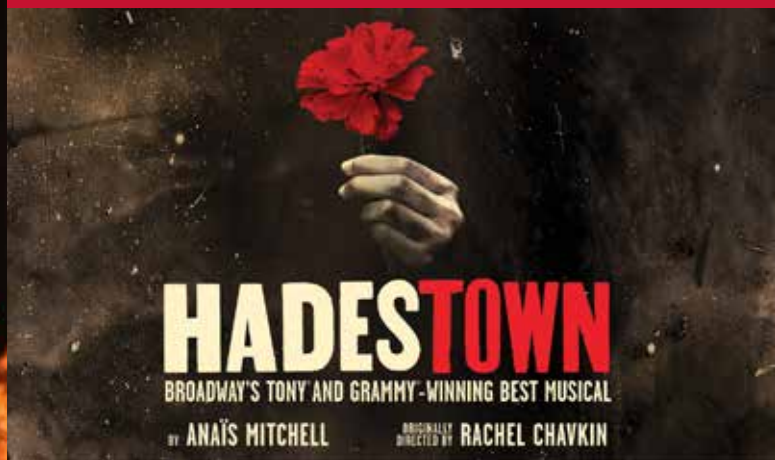

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the minimum group size to qualify?

For most shows, 10 or more people make a group. Groups are social organizations, a family get together or reunion, fundraisers, girls' night out, corporate outings, meet-up groups or just about anybody who wants to get a group of 10 or more together for a special pricing on the very best Broadway shows in America.

How do I find out about new shows, special offers and other group promotions?

Sign up at DPACnc.com to stay updated with our latest group news and new shows.

Is there a minimum age requirement for children?

All guests require a ticket, regardless of age. Children under the age of 6 will not be admitted to the theater. Children must be able to sit quietly within their own seat without disturbing other guests. As a further courtesy to our guests, DPAC recommends one parent or chaperone for every four or five children in attendance.

When is payment due? What if I can't pay for all of my group's tickets at once?

Seats for most shows can be reserved with a 10% non-refundable deposit due at the time of booking to lock in your seats, and final payments due six weeks before the show opens at DPAC. Please note for some multi-week blockbuster shows, final payments are due eight weeks prior to the show. If you reserve your tickets less than six weeks prior to the show, full payment will be due upon ordering.

What forms of payment do you accept?

You may pay by VISA, MasterCard, American Express, and Discover. You may also pay with one corporate or business check. Please note that we do not accept cash payments or individual or personal checks for group orders.

What if I need to make changes to my order or reduce or add seats?

You may modify the number of tickets you order at any time as long as you keep the minimum required for the selected performance. Prices are subject to change when purchasing additional seats based on the current rates which often do increase as the show draws closer. Please note that all tickets for a single group order must be for the same performance. Once final payment is made, all sales are final and there are no refunds or exchanges.

When and how do I get my group tickets?

Once full payments are made, your tickets will become available on your DPAC app. All tickets are now accessible on your mobile device, where the group leader can transfer tickets to the appropriate guests. By using the mobile app, this simplifies the ticket delivery process for all group leaders. For alternative delivery options, please contact Groups@DPACnc.com. Groups with 30+ tickets may be required to have printed tickets.

Where do we park our bus?

Let us know you will be bringing your group by bus, and we will provide you with information about complimentary bus parking along with convenient drop-off and pick-up areas.

Weather and Events at DPAC

During winter weather months, all performances scheduled at DPAC normally take place as planned. Under special circumstances, DPAC does offer those that miss the show the option of attending a future DPAC event as a make-good if weather or travel conditions prevent you from attending your ticketed performance.
